108/23 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST: None.

109/23 MINUTES

Having been previously circulated, the minutes of the meeting of 8th January 2023 were **approved** as an accurate record & authorised for signature by the Chairman.

110/23 PUBLIC OPEN FORUM Matters raised related to concerns about the speed of traffic especially in the light of the two recent accidents. The worst times being 8-9am and 4-5pm.

111/23 MATTERS RAISED IN PUBLIC OPEN FORUM Various ways to address the speed issue were considered including putting 30mph stickers on the dustbins of every house beside the main road, getting additional 30 roundels painted on the road and setting up a Community Speedwatch

112/23 REPORTS

- a) **Police: noted** report on January incidents emailed to councillors 2/2/24.
- b) **Unitary:** no report to receive.
- c) **Parish:** Cllr. Brooks reported 1] the traffic mirror on the Blacksmith's had moved in the recent gales (Chairman would try to sort) and 2] it was planned to hold another Open Gardens event later this year (possibly 23rd June). Cllr. Couch reported the gully outside the church rooms had still not been cleared (Clerk to inform Highways).

113/23 UPDATES ON MATTERS RAISED AT PREVIOUS MEETINGS:-

- a) Bridge at bottom of Ranter Lane over beck [Minute 104/23a) refers] – **noted** email from Cllr. Staveley confirming that Fabraweld (the firm who had made the bridge) were happy for their name to be released.

- a) Email from two parishioners with concerns re. speed of vehicles following the recent accidents were **received & noted**. The matters had already been considered from the Public Open Forum.

115/23 PLANNING MATTERS

- a) Applications Received (to agree comments) –
 - 1. ZF23/01919/FL Re-surfacing of disused railway to provide a public footpath suitable for walking and cycling, cinder rack between Burniston and Cloughton – **agreed** no objection in principle but concerns re 1] lack of signage and dog waste bins; 2] no mention of use by horses or ebikes; 3] legal status (public footpath, bridleway etc);
- b) Decisions received to note:-
 - 1. 22/01517/FL Erect 1 No dwelling (revised scheme to 21/01229/FL), Land at The Old Mill, Mill Lane – **noted** appeal dismissed.
- c) To agree comments/note any planning matters/decisions received after 30/1/24 - none.
